TIPS FOR TEACHING SUCCESS

- 1. Teach just one new thing at a time.
- 2. Teaching music isn't about teaching and it isn't about music—it is about building relationships.
- 3. During rehearsal, talk as little as possible. If you can't say what you want to say in less than three sentences, you are talking too much.
- 4. You can't change everything in your first year of teaching, but you still make a difference in the lives of your students.
- 5. When teaching new concepts, let them hear it and then imitate it. Let the reading/writing come after the experience.
- 6. Review the basics and procedures constantly.
- 7. Learn student names quickly.
- 8. Find a mentor.
- 9. Establish your rehearsal routine.
- 10. Ask questions during rehearsal that engage the student's critical thinking—ask what happened and why rather than just telling them what to do all the time.
