**Part III:** Briefly describe your activities at the college or university level, including any community service and volunteer efforts accomplished since your high school years. Be sure to include your activities in CMENC, if applicable.

**Part IV:** Write a brief essay (not to exceed 500 words) describing your career goals in music. Tell what continues to inspire you to become a music educator. Include information regarding your intended student teaching and/or intern intentions and the sort of job you expect to seek upon the completion of your degree.

**Part V:** Include two letters of reference with your application. One of the references should be from one of your college music instructors. Both letters should affirm your music abilities and your potential as a music educator.
